

## Tyler Hanson - Sound Engineering/Electronics

Tyler is a graduate of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette (B.M.-Music Media) hailing from the New Orleans area. He was a four-year member of the Pride of Acadiana marching band and served as a drumline section leader for two years. While at ULL, Tyler was also a member of the University Wind Ensemble, Jazz Ensemble, Percussion Ensemble, and Ragin' Brass basketball band. He marched two years with Louisiana Stars, one year as a member of the snareline and one year on drum set. He also performed with Voodoo Independent Percussion on drum set in 2013. Tyler taught percussion at Ponchatoula High School from 2013-2015 and served as the sound engineer for Louisiana Stars in 2016 and 2017.

Tyler is a freelance studio recording, mix, and mastering engineer, as well as a live sound engineer and technician for See Hear Productions. He has worked with various bands from around southeastern Louisiana, including Bottoms Up, Mike Foster Project, Four Unplugged, and Big Sam's Funky Nation. Through See Hear, he has also served as a technician for larger touring acts, such as Bryan Adams, John Cafferty, and the Doobie Brothers. As a drum set player, Tyler is currently a freelance studio musician and has shared the stage with the likes of Paquito D'Rivera and Diane Schuur.
